2.6.2: Attainment of POs and COs are evaluated:

Program Outcomes (PO) are overarching declarations that delineate the professional achievements that the program strives to attain. Every course is associated with distinct and quantifiable course outcomes. Every course consists of 5 or 6 units, and typically, each unit is directly related to a specific course outcome. Every course outcome is aligned with the program outcomes and program-specific objectives.

The attainment level of all course outcomes for each course is determined meticulously by evaluating the student's performance in both internal and external examinations. Hence, the achievement of course objectives is a collective outcome of both direct and indirect assessment methods. Consequently, this aids in determining the assessment of program outcomes by aligning each course outcome with specified program outcomes and program-specific objectives. In addition to this, the exit survey is administered to students as an indirect means of evaluating the program outcomes.

During the course outcome assessment, 80% of the overall achievement is derived from direct assessment, while the remaining 20% is derived from indirect assessment.
